## E-MAIL SCAM ALERT

There have been numerous emails going around that indicate there is a problem/verify your GEETEL email account. The subject varies as does the content of the emails and warnings. The emails usually include a link which you are supposed to click on to "fix or verify" your email account. Some have even gone as far as creating a FAKE GEETEL webmail login page (very easy to do) which appears legitimate.

You click on the link, they ask you to put in your username and password. Boom... they just got your username and password! The next thing they do is use your e-mail account to send out thousands of spam emails.

We would NEVER EVER send out emails like that. They keep changing the content and source of the emails to get through our spam filters. This is a similar scam they do for your bank, credit cards, etc ... No provider of services would send you emails like this. The emails are all scams... period. Simply delete the email.
